The Rt Rev Maurice Wood (1916-2007)


Bishop Maurice Wood prayer seems appropriate fort Hardenhuish:

The disciples were together by the sea of Tiberias .They must have been feeling lost and bewildered . What would they do now ? Simon Peter decided to go fishing and the other disciples agreed to join him . They went out and got into the boat , but that night they caught nothing .
